Orthopaedic centre & new Ipswich A&E set to open New James Paget Hospital at risk under Labour

The new A&E at Ipswich Hospital and the brand new Orthopaedic centre are set to open later this year. £23 million has been invested to improve the emergency department while the Dame Clare Marx building will be a new £64 million state-of-the-art centre for patients who need planned surgery on bones, joints and muscles, such as hip and knee replacements. Triple Lock PLUS is the latest boost for pensioners and will ensure dignity in retirement



The State Pension has increased by £3,736 since 2010 after accounting for inflation, largely thanks to the triple lock we introduced in 2010.

From next April, Conservatives will increase the personal allowance for pensioners in line with the Triple Lock by introducing a new age-related allowance.

The new Triple Lock Plus is a tax cut of c. £100 for 8 million pensioners. We will guarantee in legislation that the pensioners' personal allowance will rise in line with the highest of earnings, prices or 2.5% so it is higher than the state pension in each year of the next Parliament.
